

- Please remember that we are only able to hunt because landowners and farmers allow us to. Always shut gates and ensure stock does not stray. When on arable land stay close to the side in single file and never cut corners. What might appear to be overgrown grass tracks around headlands may well be part of a stewardship scheme. Do not ride on them, treat them as a crop. The financial implications of damaging these features are potentially huge.
- Participating in legal activities with the Woodland Pytchley Hunt Limited (WPH) is a sport that involves danger and risk. Those that partake do so at their own risk and should ride according to the conditions and their ability. It is also up to each individual to ensure that they are suitably equipped and have sufficient expertise for the prevailing conditions. WPH has no liability for any loss or damage suffered by you as a result of your participation.
- **You** are responsible for your own actions, losses, costs and claims arising. **You** must have your own Public Liability insurance in place prior to taking part in WPH activities and be prepared to settle any claims arising personally. This note extends to cover damage to jumps. If you cause damage **you** must ensure that the Field Master is made aware of it and that **you** ensure that the situation is remedied immediately.
